MFDS Begins Roling Review of Sputnik V COVID-19 Vaccine

- ☐ The Ministry of Food and Drug Safety (MFDS, Minister Kim Ganglip) has announced that Huons Co., Ltd. filed for rolling review of Russia's Sputnik V COVID-19 vaccine on April 29 prior to submitting an application for marketing authorization.
 - O Since Sputnik V is not included in the Korean government's COVID-19 vaccination program, Huons has filed for rolling review of the non-clinical data (toxicity and efficacy tests) in accordance with Pharmaceutical Affairs Act.
 - The MFDS will rigorously review the safety and efficacy of the vaccine, based on the submitted non-clinical data.
 - O Sputnik V is a viral vector vaccine which has been authorized in 61 countries including Russia, but not in the U.S. and the E.U.
 - The vaccine is currently under the European Medicines Agency (EMA)'s rolling review and the WHO Emergency Use Listing (EUL) evaluation.
 - * The EMA's rolling review: since March 4, 2021 The WHO EUL evaluation: since October 2020
- ☐ The MFDS will spare no effort for a timely provision of safe and effective vaccines.
